

ADDENDUM

In January 2020, Heritage Oshawa alerted City of Oshawa staff that they had determined that 121 Columbus Road West was not a potential cultural heritage resource, and should not have been identified as such in the Cultural Heritage Resource Assessment (C.H.R.A.) for the Integrated Columbus Part II Planning Act and Municipal Class Environmental Assessment Act Study prepared by ASI and dated February 2019. A memorandum prepared by ASI dated January 28, 2020 confirms this new finding and updates the C.H.R.A. In particular, the memorandum notes that:

“As such, there are now a total of 61 recognized and potential cultural heritage resources within the study area of the Integrated Columbus Part II Planning Act and Municipal Class Environmental Assessment Act Study, of which 29 have been identified as potential cultural heritage resources.”

The Integrated Columbus Part II Planning Act and Municipal Class Environmental Assessment Act Study Planning Background Considerations Report May 2019 includes a summary of the findings of the C.H.R.A. in Section 3.6 of the Report. The reference to “30 potential cultural heritage resources identified during the field review” in the report is hereby amended to delete the number “30” and replace it with the number “29”. Similarly, Map 9 Cultural Heritage Resources, is amended to delete the subject property.
