Entry Drop-off Information

Drop-off times:

- Friday, June 6, 3 p.m. to 6 p.m.
- Saturday, June 7, 7 a.m. to 8:45 a.m.

Where to enter the building for drop-off:

- Participants may enter at the back of the building on the north side of the building.
- Please note: the main arena doors will be locked at 4 p.m. on Friday, June 6 and will remain closed to the public until 11 a.m. on Saturday, June 6.

Parking:

- Friday, June 6, you may use the main parking lot at Children's Arena and proceed to the rear of the arena.
- Saturday, June 7 the main parking lot is for vendors, and accessible parking only, entrants must find alternate on-street parking.

Judging Information

The judging of exhibitions will take place on Saturday, June 7 between 8:45 a.m. and 11 a.m.

- Sunday, June 8 10 a.m.

Show Schedule – Entry Information

Exhibitors must register with the Show Committee in the setup area upon arrival. The setup area will be located at the rear exit of the arena.

- The Show is open to those who have grown the peonies they intend to enter.
- Registrants may be an individual, a commercial grower or a botanical garden.
- All entries must be placed by Saturday, June 7 at 8:45 a.m.
- C.P.S. will provide containers for specimen entries.
- Registrants may place any number of different cultivars in each class.
- Each entry must have an entry tag attached including the class number, cultivar name (if known) and exhibitor name. C.P.S. will provide entry tags at registration.
- Please show peonies with stems 12 14" long with the top leaves only.
- The decision of the Judges shall be final.
- The Judges may withhold an award if, in their opinion, the exhibit is not worthy.
- C.P.S. will award ribbons for first, second, and third place in all divisions, "Best in Show" ribbons, and one "Grand Champion" ribbon.
- The Canadian Peony Society, the Oshawa Valley Botanical Gardens, and the City of Oshawa assume no responsibility for the loss or damage to entries.
